


RANIER ROSÉ

Tomasello Ranier Rosé is a moderately sweet rosé wine with the taste of freshly picked grapes. Made primarily from the Native American grape known as the Catawba, the fruity, intense character is well-suited as a dessert wine beyond the table. It is perfect with poultry, semi-soft cheeses or slightly spicy dishes. Made for over 86 years at our family's vineyard, it enjoys a very loyal following that continues to grow every day! For the sweeter palette, it is of medium intensity for the Ranier collection.
